

2012 Red Show

A Call for Artwork Submission

Paint the Town Red. Works of art featuring the hues of red.

Eligibility:

Open to all Minnesota artists over the age of 18 only. Entries must be original work created solely by the artist in the last 5 years and not previously exhibited at Maple Grove Art Center (MGAC). Both 2D and 3D artwork will be allowed. Hues of red must feature prominently in the work – 60% and above.

Media:

Recent paintings, drawings, fibers, batik, hand pulled prints, sculpture, and photography

*Photography that is digitally enhanced is allowed if clearly marked as such.

Conditions:

Artwork must be original. Oil painting must be dry. Drawings, prints, watercolors, fibers, batik and photography must be under glass. All two-dimensional work must have wire for hanging. Display structure of three-dimensional items must be provided by the artist.

All excepted entries must remain on exhibit for the duration of the show – February 6 – 29, 2012.

Every precaution will be taken in handling artwork, but no responsibility is assumed by MGAC for loss or damage of any kind. Maple Grove Art Center cannot be responsible for loss or damage. Submission of these works indicates acceptance of these conditions. Artists who desire to insure their work must make their own arrangements.

Exclusions:

No copies, class-work, food-stuffs, hazardous materials or fragile work can be accepted.

Exhibition Hours:

Mondays 1:00 – 4:00 p.m. and Tuesdays 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m., Thursdays 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. and evenings 7:30 – 9:00 p.m.

The Gallery is also open to the public during classes – see website for class times. You can also make an appointment to view the Gallery

Submission of work:

Registration form and procedures attached. Artwork, entry form, fee and release must be delivered to MGAC at time of submission. Pre-registration is however greatly appreciated. Email completed entry forms and photos of work to LLink@maplegroveartscenter.org, subject: RED SHOW 2012.

Entry Fees:

- Non-MGAC Advocate artists, \$25.00 for each entry – maximum of two will be considered.
- MGAC Advocate artists, \$15.00 for each entry – maximum of three will be considered.
- Advocate application and fees accepted at time of entry. *Become an advocate and enjoy the benefits all year long!*

Sales:

Payment is made directly to the artist. Center requires a 20% donation on all sales resulting from this show. Artists are responsible for all related sales tax.

Awards:

Cash awards and ribbons presented during the opening reception.

Best of Show , \$250 (one will be awarded)

Award of Excellence \$75 (one will be awarded)

Merit Award \$25 (two will be awarded)

ALL awards are subject to the discretion of the Juror, and decisions will be final. Winners are responsible for any related sales tax.
